



What is AI use and what are the risks of using it in assessments, leading towards qualifications?

AI use refers to you using AI tools to obtain information and content which might be used to produce work for assessments, leading towards qualifications. However, please be aware that a **misuse** of AI tools for qualification assessments at any time constitutes **malpractice!**

An example of AI tools are AI chatbots, which generate text in response to your prompts and questions, which revise responses already provided by questions you have asked.

However, AI chatbots generate responses from your questions and prompts, which are statistically likely to be relevant. Please be aware that AI tools can produce inaccurate content.

The use of AI chatbots can be a major risk for you if used when completing qualification assessments. A misuse of AI tools for qualification assessments at any time constitutes **malpractice**. AI chatbots often produce answers that contain incorrect information.

Ormiston Sandwell Community Academy will discuss the use of AI in qualification assessments and manage your use of AI, and ensure you are aware of the appropriate and inappropriate use of AI, the risks of using AI, and the possible consequences of using AI inappropriately in a qualification assessment.

You will be reminded about submitting your own independent work (a result of your own efforts, independent research, etc) for assessments and stress to you the risks of plagiarism and malpractice.

Ormiston Sandwell Community Academy will explain that your teachers and assessors are familiar with AI tools, their risks and AI detection tools and the risks of using it in assessments and a misuse of using AI tools. Teachers will ensure you know that examiners and moderators know how to report and investigate malpractice, and procedures will be followed if a **misuse** of AI tools during qualification assessments is identified.
